Triumph Palace Moscow

With a height of 264 meters and 54 floors, Triumph Palace in the centre of Moscow is the tallest building in Europe.

During construction the building was given the nickname "Stalin's 8th Sister", because it looks very similar to the "Seven Sisters Towers" built during the time of Stalin.

EUROFOX was responsible for the overall planning as well as the façade engineering static calculations for the project, for which over 48,000 m² (517000 sq ft) of EUROFOX support systems were supplied.
